ABSTRACT SUBMISSION GUIDELINES FOR ORAL PAPER

- **Type of presentation** – Free oral paper
- **Word count** for the abstract submission is 250 words
- **Format-** Brief background, including research/study's rationale, aims & objectives, material & methods (comprehensive), results, & conclusion (The relative importance given to each sub-heading can vary depending on the type of research work – original paper, case-series, etc.).
- **Type of Research Work** - An original work, systematic review/meta-analysis (preferred); case-series, or case-reports are also allowed, but no review or perspective is allowed.
- **Fonts** - Times/Calibri, size 12.
- **Authors' details** – Name, designation, email id, contact no, affiliation to be provided
- **Sending the entries** - The abstract by filling out the form attached to this link, on or before 10th November 2025

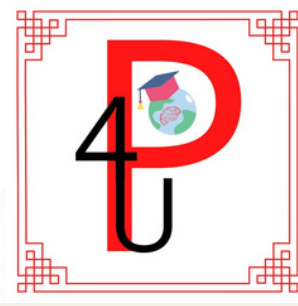

GUIDELINE FOR ORAL PAPER PRESENTATION

- The candidate intending to present their paper needs to compulsorily register themselves for the conference
- Only the candidate who in-person attends the conference and makes a presentation shall receive the presentation certificate
- **Last date for sending the presentation to the scientific committee** is 19th November 2025 at <https://forms.gle/tUDTnULKtEW9eSer9>
- The presentation should preferably be in **MS- PowerPoint (.ppt)** to ensure compatibility with the computer system
- **Number of slides** – The candidate is required to restrict their PPT to 10 slides (excluding reference slide)
- A rough **slide distribution** can be introduction (1 slide); rationale and aims & objectives (1 slide); material and methods (3-4 slides); results (2-3 slides); conclusion (1 slide)
- **Presentation duration** (10 minutes) – 7 minutes for presentation & 3 minutes for Q&A
- The system shall be equipped with a timer and the auto-cut facility; hence, the candidate is required to rehearse the presentation beforehand hand & adhere to time
- It is encouraged that the presenter bring their PPT on a pen-drive to get it uploaded in the system (this can be in addition to mailing it to the scientific committee)
- At the podium, personal laptops are not permitted.

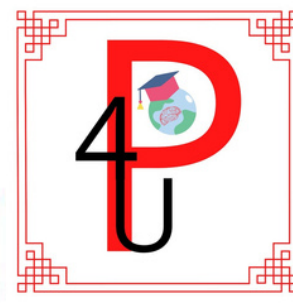
